## **THE PAR 27 PUTTING CHALLENGE**

I've Spoken before about the need to measure your practice and the value of competing against yourself over a period of time. I've also said on this forum many times about the value of putting practice and how it can transform your scores. Here's a drill tour players regularly use to a) practice their technique and b) measure their progress. It's called Par 27 Putting and it takes 5 minutes

Go to the Putting green with 6 golf balls

- Find a relatively straight area of the putting green approx. 30 ft. long
- Hit 6 putts from 3 feet. You are expected to hole all 6 in one = par 6
- Hit 6 putts from 8 feet. You are expected to hole 3 and 2 putt 3 = par 9
- Hit 6 putts from 30 feet. You are expected to 2 putt all of them =
  Par 12
- TOTAL PAR = 27

A score of 27 or better = You are an outstanding Putter A score of 27-32 = You are a reasonable Putter A score of 32-35 = You need to work on your putting A score of 35 or more = You need to book a lesson ©

It's a great way to improve your putting if you do it regularly. Good Luck!!
