Ping has unveiled its new G400 series, a new range of woods and irons that will replace the popular G range and feature a host of new innovations and technologies said to take performance levels to new heights.

Like in the G range, the G400 trio of drivers are designed to offer different launch and ball flight capabilities, all of which feature a faster forged face for higher ball speeds, a smaller more streamlined clubhead to maximize swing speed, improved sound and feel as well as unique paint shift technology on the shaft.

The Ping G400 fairway woods and hybrids are made from a stronger maraging steel, meaning the clubfaces could be made thinner and lighter to provide more ball speed while also making them more forgiving.

The G400 Crossover has a drastically different look to the original G Crossover, and should get the ball in the air a little easier and hold its line better on mishits than its predecessor thanks to tungsten toe weighting that raises forgiveness levels.

STEPHENS TIP OF THE WEEK



HOW HIGH SHOULD I TEE THE BALL UP?

It's amazing how many people ask this question and indeed how many people tee the ball up at an incorrect height for the club they are using.

The answer depends on the design of the club you are using or more specifically how high the clubface is.

- With a driver the best height to tee the ball up should see approx 1/3 of the ball covered by the clubface and the other 2/3's above the clubface.
 - With the 3 wood leave about $\frac{1}{2}$ the ball above the clubface and $\frac{1}{2}$ the ball covered.
- For fairway woods and hybrids leave only 1/3 of the ball above the clubface and 2/3's covered.
- On par 3's when using an iron, press the tee all the way into the ground so that only its head is above ground

Often when playing into a stiff breeze players tend to tee the ball down lower than normal in an effort to flight the ball lower. This can often have the opposite effect as the resulting steep angle of attack will in fact send the ball higher in the air.

Into the wind tee the ball up at the same height and simply concentrate on a slow rhythmic swing.
