STANDING ORDERS FOR EGM on 18th June 2026

1. Fifty full members entitled to vote shall constitute a quorum at the Extraordinary General Meeting. In the event that a quorum is not present within 30 minutes of the appointed time, the meeting shall be terminated.
2. Subject to the discretion of the Chair, the proposer of a motion shall be allowed not more than four minutes, the seconder two minutes and each succeeding speaker two minutes.
3. The maximum time, which shall be allocated to a motion, shall be limited to thirty minutes.
4. Subject to the discretion of the Chair, no member shall be permitted to speak more than once on the same motion except the proposer of the motion who shall have right to reply.
5. The vote on motion shall be by ballot unless the meeting determines otherwise.
6. Standing orders may be suspended on a two-thirds majority vote of the members present at the meeting.
7. The Chair shall have the absolute right to decide at any time when motion has been sufficiently discussed and may put the motion to the meeting giving the proposer the right of reply before doing so.
8. At EGM the decision of the Chair on any question of procedure shall be final.
9. In the event of a tie the Chair shall have the casting vote.
10. Voting will be carried out as follows
 - a) Only full members who have registered and are attending the meeting will be eligible to vote.
 - b) For members attending in person voting will be by a show of hands.
11. At the outset of EGM tellers shall be appointed by the Chairperson. Their duty shall be to ascertain and report to the Chairperson the number voting for or against a motion on which a poll is taken.
12. The Chair shall inform the meeting of the results of all votes of ballots and declare the result, which shall be final.
